RE: a-Round Green Lake Association Inc., July 4 land parade

We as an Association wanted to inform all of the candidates for Supervisor of Leighton Township and any other candidates (hence the reason to include the Clerk on this Memo) running for office, that we have had to make some rules regarding our July 4 land parade. We weren't sure if you intended to participate in our parade but if you are planning on it, we wanted you to be aware well in advance. These rules have had to be made this year due to Covid19 and recommendations from the Allegan County Health Dept., and the Allegan County Sheriff's office:

1. We are asking that no parade participants walk in the parade. We are allowing children to ride bikes but if you intend to participate, please ride in a motor vehicle, golf cart etc.
2. We will leave it up to your discretion if you wish to wear a mask because this is an outdoor event, but please abide by our County Health Department's Covid19 recommendations including 6' of social distancing. Their other suggestions can be found on their website.
3. We ask that if you intend to pass out anything to the public, that those passing out items wear gloves and that such items be limited to wrapped candy. We ask that you not distribute any flyers, pencils, buttons, leaflets or other similar type items.

If you choose to participate in our land parade, line-up begins at 11:30am on Saturday, July 4 at the Green Lake Calvary Church parking lot. Our Board member, Tyce DeBoer, is in charge of the event and will direct you as to where your space will be in the parade. The parade route is the same as it has been for the past several years and is roughly 1.5 miles long. Thank you for your understanding as we navigate these ever changing Covid19 times and ask everyone to do their part to keep our community healthy and safe.
