Residents in the township have access to additional recycling services. For many years the **Allegan County Health Department (ACHD)** has collected Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) by appointment.

ACHD contracts to collect, sort and dispose of HHW making this a great way to properly dispose of harmful chemicals from residential use such as the items listed...

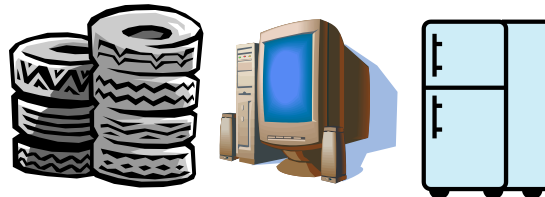
Salem Twp. Depot Station

You must bring your Resource Recovery Card!

Resource Recovery Cards are available at the Township Hall.

Hours: Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday 9:00–4:00 PM. Ph. # (616) 891-8238

Your Resource Recovery Card allows you to recycle tires (4 per year), Styrofoam, appliances (2 per year) (stoves, microwaves, dishwasher, refrigerator, TV (1 per year)/computer/electronic items) and scrap metal recycling.



Materials can be taken to the Salem Twp. Transfer Station located at 4145 29th Street, Dorr, MI.

This station is open on the 1st and 3rd Saturdays of the month between 8:30am-3:30 pm. (Closed Jan & Feb.)
