5. Fire Chief Weston gave the monthly department report. They received a \$5000.00 gift from the A-round Green Lake Association which they applied to the purchase of new extrication equipment. They also received \$2900.00 from Ladder 34 from the donated expired hose. Their roster is currently at 28.
6. Motion by Hooker, support by Nieuwenhuis to approve Dan Pratt as a new probationary firefighter. All members voted yes. Motion carried.
7. The Planning Commission reported approval of a SUP for concrete and asphalt recycling on Electric Avenue. (Velting)
8. The Building Inspector reported 1 new home permit in November and 53 year to date.
9. The Green Lake Sewer reported that the Glen Drive rebuild is finished except for the final paving to be done in the spring of 2020.
10. Raecale Stull and Laura Smith from the Allegan Conservation District gave a brief report.
11. Public Comment: Steve Shoemaker asked about the status of the old Jaws equipment. It will be used for back-up.
12. Deer reported that the trees have been removed from the Green Lake Park.
13. Steve Shoemaker reported that the citizen's road committee has met and will continue to meet over the coming months to prioritize road projects and look at creative funding.
