#### **Voting Methods**

#### **VOTING METHOD #1**

#### **ABSENTEE**

Any registered voter can vote with an absentee ballot. There is no requirement for an excuse.

#### There are 2 steps to this process:

1) Submit a ballot application

(unless you have previously submitted a permanent ballot application)

#### 2) Return your voted ballot

by mail or absentee ballot drop box (location listed on front of brochure)

BALLOTS MUST ARRIVE AT CLERK'S
OFFICE BEFORE 8:00 PM ON ELECTION DAY

- Online at Mi.gov/Vote
- Request from the Clerk's office
- Visit the Clerk's office

Returning your ballot to the Township or one of the drop boxes is strongly recommended instead of mailing
