A NOTE FROM LTFD

With heating season upon us, the LTFD reminds residents to keep chimney safety a priority. Schedule an annual chimney inspection, keep the area around your fireplace clear, and never use flammable liquids to start a fire. Make sure your smoke and carbon monoxide detectors are working properly.

For added safety, use a fireplace screen, install a chimney cap, and burn only seasoned hardwood to help reduce creosote buildup.
